

# **GUIDANCE NEWS**

"Building resilience in children is not about making them tough.
Resilience is the ability to recover from difficulties and manage how you feel." Our theme for the year in character education is Resliency.
Research has established resilience as essential for human thriving, and an ability necessary for the development of healthy, adaptable young people. It's what enables children to emerge from challenging experiences with a positive sense of themselves and their futures.
Children who develop resiliency are better able to face disappointment, learn from failure, cope with loss, and adapt to change. We recognize resilience in children when we observe their determination, grit, and perseverance to tackle problems and cope with the emotional challenges of school and life.

Each month we will focus on one of the components of resiliency.
"Honesty" is the theme for September, and we will be discussing how students can appropriately speak, express their concerns and share their perspective.
