#### **HEALTH ROOM UPDATE**

If your little pirate will begin a new medication or has a change in a new/current medication after the holiday break that would have to be administered during the school day, please contact Mrs. Rader, or stop by the school. A Medication Administration Authorization form that must be completed and signed by the medical provider and parent. A School Health Aide, may only administer medication to a student if she has been authorized by the student's medical provider AND parent

Your child CAN ONLY self-carry an asthma inhaler/Epi-pen if the Medication Administration Authorization packet has been completed, signed off and on file by your student's medical provider and their parent. If your student has an asthmatic or seizure episode while at school and the Health Aide office does not have a Medication Administration Authorization form or any medications logged in or on file, 911 will be contacted to assess the medical situation, we will not risk a student's health and safety.

Over-the-Counter (OTC) cough drops, nasal sprays/solution, lotions, eye drops CAN NOT be brought to school by your student to self-administer. Parents are always welcome to come to the school to administer OTC or prescribed medication to their child when and if needed without an Authorized Medication packet at any time.
