TAP

The Transitioning Adults Program (T.A.P) is designed for individuals aged 18 to 21 with disabilities in the Nassau County School District who have met graduation requirements and are focused on achieving employment. The T.A.P staff assists these young adults in identifying their dreams and goals through various functional academics and transition assessments. These assessments include interest inventories, vocational assessments, career inventories, and self-determination scales. The insights gained from these evaluations are then actively implemented and practiced within the community.



Yulee High School and BRIDGE Program

The Yulee High School Class provides opportunities for post-graduate students to enhance their independent living skills through various classroom activities and campus experiences, enabling them to actively participate in everyday life.

The BRIDGE program offers post-graduate students the ability to learn job readiness skills a few times a week and engage in weekly community-based instruction.

Project SEARCH

Project SEARCH is our most rigorous program, offering postgraduate students the opportunity to immerse themselves in a host business. Graduates of Project SEARCH often secure employment as a result of this experience.

WHY DEFER RECEIPT OF YOUR DIPLOMA?

These programs provide valuable instruction in independent living skills and job readiness, helping to bridge the gap between students' goals and their lives after school.
