- Our guidance counselors will be contacting parents beginning May 1<sup>st</sup> to schedule any necessary end of the year conferences. In order to have final grades for report cards, all student work, both digital and paper packets, must be submitted by May 20<sup>th</sup>. Report cards will be posted in FOCUS on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Student elective requests for the 2020-2021 school year will be available electronically on individual student ELA Google classrooms, school websites, and/or school Facebook pages from May 1<sup>st</sup> -15<sup>th</sup>. Upcoming 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will have access to the elective request form via their current school's website.
- Textbooks, laptops, library books, etc... will be collected May 20-22. Individual school sites will post their collection hours and procedures at a later date. Students will be able to retrieve personal items and yearbooks on these days, as well.
