Your child should receive their weekly assignments for all classes by Friday, April 3rd. These assignments should be completed and submitted electronically to the teacher no later than Friday, April 10th.

All assignments will be graded and posted to FOCUS by 4:00 p.m. the Thursday after submissions.

If you do not have Internet access, you need to contact your child's school, and someone will follow up with you as soon as possible.
