This is Dr. John Mazzella calling, your child's High School Principal.

I am calling to keep you informed concerning possible future events and other important information:

- All 10th and 11th grade students who requested a Dual Enrollment FBHS English or Math class for next school year and needs to take the PERT to qualify: FSCJ has set up remote online testing to replace the PERT. Follow the directions to complete and submit the form to FSCJ to schedule an appointment. The form is on our website: fernandinahigh.com
Email your counselor if you are not sure if you need a test score.
- Seniors: Our Senior Graduation ceremony has been rescheduled for one of two dates: Monday, June 22 at 9:00 a.m. or Monday, July 13 at 9:00 a.m. and will be held at the Pirate Field and Stadium. There will be more information shared as we get closer to the date of the event.
- Seniors and Juniors: Originally, we had postponed the Junior Senior Prom and rescheduled it for May 9th in hopes that we might be able to return to regular classes. With the closing of campus for the remainder of the school year, and rescheduling of our Graduation ceremony, we are now going to reschedule our prom for the same week as graduation with the exact date not known at this time. Once we have established this date, we will notify everyone.

- Once students join the Remind they can message their School Counselor and also receive any important announcements related to their grade level.
