- All 10th and 11th grade students who requested a Dual Enrollment FBHS English or Math class for next school year and needs to take the PERT to qualify: FSCJ has set up remote online testing to replace the PERT, which is called the Accuplacer Test. Follow the directions to complete and submit the form to FSCJ to schedule an appointment.
