## **Home Education – Educating your Student at Home other than Option 1, 2, or 3**

If parents are going to Home Education, breaking ties with the public school, then they can follow the instructions listed below. IEP and 504’s are not supported while a student is actively registered as a Home Education student. However, walk in speech is offered to Home Education students through NCSD.
