Advanced Placement (AP) Description

- Program of college courses and exams
- Administered nationally since 1955 by the College Board
- AP courses make it possible for academically talented students to increase the challenge of their studies
- Essentially, AP courses allow students to pursue college-level studies while still in high school.

Advanced Placement (AP)

Students must understand:

- **OAP courses are college level courses**
 - Homework is difficult and time consuming
 - Test preparation sessions
- The student is making a commitment,
 Must be willing to invest time and effort
 - Couse cannot be dropped.

Advanced Placement (AP) The Exam

- AP Exams are administered in May
- All students are required to take the exam
 - Examination fees are paid by the school
 - No shows must repay the exam fee of \$94 (\$142 for AP Capstone courses)

Many colleges give credit for AP courses.
 Students earning a 3 or higher usually earn college credit or exemptions from required classes.

Advanced Placement (AP) AP or Dual Enrollment

Advanced Placement

- Open Enrollment with course prerequisites
- May receive college credit based on score (school dependent)
- Poor grade impacts only your high school GPA

Dual Enrollment

- GPA, PERT score, and course prerequisites
- College credit guaranteed in Florida (and others)
- Grade will go on high school and college transcript
 - HS: 1 credit per course
 - College: 3 credit hours




