

Parking Rules and Regulations

In order to purchase a parking tag, you must:

1. Pay the appropriate amount in full.
2. Have valid Driver's license. (show at time of purchase)
3. Show current proof of insurance.
4. Provide completed Nassau County School Board Drug Consent form – must be notarized and signed by a parent/guardian.
5. Provide student signed registration form.

All vehicles parked on campus must be registered with the Dean's Office and have a parking permit displayed.

- Any vehicle that does not have a current FBHS parking permit, parked in the wrong parking space or parked in an unauthorized area will result in a \$10.00 citation and loss of parking privilege until the citation is paid.
- Students determined to have illegally obtained or distributed parking permits will forfeit their right to park on campus the remainder of the school year. You may not allow someone else to use your parking permit for any reason.
- Students observed driving in a reckless or careless manner or who leave campus during the school day without permission will lose parking privileges and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- Decals must be displayed at all times on campus.
- Replacement decals are \$10.
- All questions concerning parking should be directed to the Dean's Office.

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NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD STUDENT DRUG TESTING CONSENT FORM

I understand that submission to testing for the presence of drugs and alcohol is a condition of participation in extracurricular activities and for the operation of a motor vehicle on school property. I further understand that if I refuse to take the test, or if the test establishes a violation of the drug testing policy, I will face disciplinary action set forth by the Nassau County School Board policy.

By signing and dating this form, I consent to any random or reasonable suspicion drug testing that might be required during the 2020-2021 school-year. The random testing will be done throughout the school year. The selection for the random testing will be performed by the testing agency with the selected students being notified on the day they are to report for drug testing. I also understand the provisions of reasonable suspicion testing.

By signing and dating this form I understand that the costs for random and reasonable suspicion testing will be paid for by the school district. I also understand that the cost for the assessment and rehabilitation program, in the event of a violation of the drug testing policy, is the responsibility of the student.

I hereby consent to the administration of a drug test, if selected, and to the conditions listed in this consent. By signing and dating this form I attest that I have read and understand Nassau County School Board Rule 2.48, which outlines the district drug testing policy printed in the Code of Student Conduct.
