

THINGS STUDENTS NEED TO KNOW FOR AP EXAMS(*Revised 5/3)

1. Make sure you are well rested and have a good breakfast. FBHS dress code will be enforced.
2. Make sure you arrive **BEFORE** the scheduled exam start time. Students will not be admitted once the exam has started
3. Make sure you know the date, time and location of each of your exams. The schedule and, testing locations are included in this hand-out. Additional testing location information (for the AP exams to be administered off campus will be provided at a later date.
4. Students will be dismissed only at the end of the testing period, not when they finish the test.
5. Your absences for the testing periods are excused. For AM exams, students should report to school (after testing) for *the start of 5th period. For PM exams students may leave school after 2nd period. AM Wednesday testing students will not be required to return to school. You do not need to check in/out of the Attendance Office.
6. Any other absence from school before or after testing will not be excused.
7. You are responsible for each test you do not take or complete. If you do not take the exam, the fee is \$94.00. If you start an exam and do not complete it for any reason, the fee is \$94.00. Any fees owed to FBHS must be paid in Cash by May, 18, 2018.
8. *AP exam grades can be cancelled by College Board if a student uses a cell phone or any other electronic device during the exam, or during a break. If a student posts to any form of social media during the exam, the student's score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and the student may be permanently barred from testing. Do not bring or use any electronic device (including smart watches) to the testing area even during breaks. They will be confiscated and you will be dismissed from testing. Your scores will be invalidated.*
9. If you are scheduled for two exams in one day you will have to leave the testing room while we switch from the AM exam to the PM exam. Bring a snack with you to eat quickly in another area, but do not plan on leaving the testing area.

What to bring to the exam

- *Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers)
- *Pens with black or blue ink
- *A watch (in case the room does not have a clock)
- *An approved calculator for the AP Calculus/Stats/Chemistry*/Biology exams. See www.collegeboard.com for a list of approved calculators
- *Your social security number and photo ID

What NOT to bring to the exam

- *Electronic devices
- *Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils.
- *Scratch paper
- *Rulers and straightedges
- *Food or drinks
- *Watches that beep or smartwatches
- *Clothing with subject-related information
- *Earbuds
