Thank you PTO for always going out of your way to celebrate students and staff members at Yulee Elementary School!

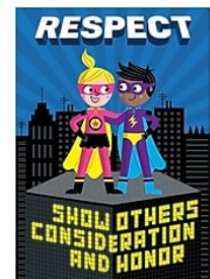
