A Picture ID is always required for ANYONE checking out a student.

The following rules apply to CMS students planning to attend the WNHS Homecoming Activities:

- 1. Parents must Call CMS at 879-3606 to verify who is checking out the student, if it is someone other than a person listed on the students' emergency card, by 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 15th ,2024. We will be unable to make any changes to the list after Tuesday, October 15th ,2024.
- 2. No student may check out without parent permission and verification of this form. THE PERSON PICKING UP STUDENT MUST PROVIDE PICTURE ID.
- 3. No student will be dismissed using this form before 11:15 a.m.
- 4. No student will be called out of the cafeteria. Please make sure you check with your student to see when he/she goes to lunch. Students do not have their belongings and backpacks in the cafeteria.
