Academic and Career Programs:

Yulee High School offers a wide curriculum which includes Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Honors and Career/Technical Programs.

Advanced Placement-The following AP courses are offered at YHS: English Literature and Composition, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, European History, American History, World History, Macro Economics, Stats, Human Geography, Psychology, Language, Lit, and US Government.

Dual Enrollment-DE is offered to 11th and 12th graders in conjunction with Florida State College of Jacksonville to allow high school students to earn both high school and college credit. YHS offers 8 on campus dual enrollment courses, including ENC 1101, ENC1102, SLS 1103, OCB2000c, MAC1105, STA 2023, BSC 2010c & BSC2011c.

Honors-Courses are offered in English 1 & 2, Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Precalculus, Agriscience, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, World History, Humanities, and US History, Spanish 3 & 4, French 3 & 4, 2D Studio Art 3, Journalism 5 & 6, Accounting, Chorus 5, Band 5.

Career/Technical Programs- YHS offers programs in Automotive, Allied Health, Building Construction, Web Design, Game Foundations, and Business Technology.

Class Rank:

Senior class rank for valedictorian and salutatorian shall be based on a 5.0 weighted GPA on all courses taken for high school credit. Calculations of GPAs for valedictorian and salutatorian shall be made at the conclusion of the last semester of the senior year.

Grading Scale-A=90-100, B=80-89, C=70-79, D=60-69, F=59 and below. Grade Point Average-AP, DE and honors courses are weighted with one (1) additional point for a full credit and a half (.5) a point for a half credit.

School and Community

Yulee High School is one of four high schools in Nassau County. The school was re-opened in 2006, after Yulee went 40 years without a community high school. YHS serves approximately 1,400 students with over 100 faculty members, located just north of the metropolitan city of Jacksonville, Florida. YHS operates on a 7 period day consisting of four 9 week grading periods beginning in August and ending in May.

Our population is comprised of 83% White and 12% African-American with the remaining 5% divided between Hispanic, Asian, Multi-Racial and American Indian. Approximately 35% of the students qualify for free or reduced federal meal program.
