 Right to Request Teacher/Paraprofessional Qualifications

Dear Parent/Guardian:


In accordance with ESEA Section 1112(e)(1)(A) *PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW*, the Nassau County School District is notifying every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child’s classroom teacher. The following information is available upon request to my office:

- Whether your child’s teacher has met Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) qualification and licensing criteria for the grade level(s) and subject area(s) in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether FLDOE requirements have been waived to allow the teacher to teach under emergency or other provisional status;
- The teacher’s college major and the field of discipline or specialization for any advanced degrees/certifications held by the teacher;
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications;

Nassau County School District will also provide you with your child’s level of achievement on the **Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.)** and will inform you of whether your child has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.
