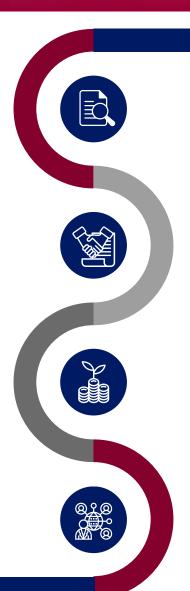
PSAT/SAT TESTING IS GOING DIGITAL

Students planning to take the PSAT/SAT this year need to prepare now for upcoming changes. In-School PSAT testing will be digital in the Fall of 2023, and the SAT will be digital in the Spring of 2024. The digital assessment requires an active college board student account.

Here are a few helpful tips to prepare for the digital PSAT/SAT this year.



Download Bluebook

If testing on a personal device, download the Bluebook application to start exploring the app. **Download Bluebook here.**

*All NSCD-issued computers already have the application.

SAT School Day: All students, including NVS - FLVS will use a NCSD device.

Approved Testing Devices

Bluebook will operate on a Windows or Mac device, an iPad, or a school-managed Chromebook. The device must be able to connect to Wi-Fi, and it must be fully charged to operate for 3-4 hours. **More info**.

Practice and Preparation

Students can start practicing now. CollegeBoard offers <u>full-length practice</u> <u>tests here</u>. Begin preparing for the digital PSAT/SAT using <u>Khan Academy</u> <u>by clicking here</u>. The format will be different than the paper-based test, so begin preparing NOW.

Registration

Students do not not need to register for the Fall PSAT or Spring school-day SAT, but students do need to register by the <u>required deadlines</u> for the Saturday testing in the Spring. For students that <u>will need to borrow a</u> <u>device from CollegeBoard</u>, they will register and request their device earlier than the registration deadline.
