QUESTIONS:

- 1. Does the 292 room total referenced in the RFP equal the total number of classrooms in the district?
 - a. No, just the specific number of classrooms.
 - b. Classroom totals have changed to the following: BES = 20, CES = 38, Emma Love = 37, HES = 50, SES = 39, YES = 49, YPS = 57 PROJECT TOTAL = 290
- 2. What is the anticipated number of "Single Individual Rooms" to be purchased outside of the 292 stated in the RFP?
 - a. A minimum of 18 rooms are currently under construction. Additional needs would be based on growth within the District.
- 3. Since projector lamps have an approximate 1 year shelf life and since todays projector lamps normally deliver 4,000 hours to 6,000 hours of use (@ 5 classroom hours per day that equals 4 to 5 years) and come with a 3 month to 12 month warranty (varies by manufacturer) would the district consider changing "1 no-cost replacement lamp for every 3 projectors purchased" to the industry norm of 1 lamp per 10 projectors?
 - a. Based on our experience, this is the ratio that is required.
- 4. Under the "Infrastructure & Control System" specifications it appears that this describes a product manufactured by "RoomPro". Since this is a proprietary product will the district consider an industry standard, functional equivalent solution and can the support equipment be mounted on the plate or would you prefer a wall mounted shelf?
 - a. The district will consider an industry standard, functional equivalent solution.
 - b. It will not be acceptable to have any equipment visible in the classroom other than the DVD/VCR, WALL PLATE/CONTROLLER.
 - c. There is already a shelf in each room for the DVD/VCR.
- 5. The "Infrastructure" section specifies a 2x2 mount with 4 built in speakers. According to *The American Academy of Audiology Clinical Guidelines* for classroom sound systems (copy attached) and several other similar studies, this is the least effective means of providing properly distributed sound in a classroom. Will the district consider a solution that strategically places the speakers in the classroom?
 - a. The speaker arrangement described in the RFP is what we are looking for.
- 6. Could you please clarify what you expect from the RJ-45 wired Lan input to the projector and more specifically are you looking for Audio & Video to cross the Lan and go directly to the projector via the RJ-45 connection on the projector or is the Lan transport of the Audio & Video to go through the PC or Laptop that will be connected to the projector?
 - a. We expect audio/video to cross the LAN & go directly to the projector through the RJ-45 connection. In other words, the projector will be just another device on the school network.
- 7. In the "Microphone" section you specify a single pendent style microphone but you ask for 2 channels "A & B". With a single microphone would a single channel controller be sufficient?
 - a. No, 2 channels are required.
- 8. The "Installation" specification calls for a "CTS" certification. Will you accept other similar or higher certifications such as those from "CEDIA" *The Custom Electronics Design & Installation Association*?
 - a. Yes, that would be acceptable, with proof.

- 9. You have specified that an uninstall of older equipment is to be included in the installation. Please explain what older equipment is in place and the quantity? When can a site visit be scheduled to see a typical uninstall configuration?
 - a. Current projectors, wall plates, controllers, cabling, DVD/VCR, document camera.
 - b. I would be willing to meet a typical site and Yulee Primary School due to its' unusual ceiling type as mentioned in question #13.
- 10. Who will be responsible for all the electrical work associated with the 21st Century Classroom Installations?
 - a. Sufficient electrical already exists above the suspended ceilings for the equipment.
- 11. Will the network connections be supplied by the district/others or is this in the scope of the AV contractor
 - a. Network Connections will be supplied by the District.
- 12. Required network configurations will be done by the district?
 - a. Required network connections will be done by the District.
- 13. Can specific details be given about the rooms, ceiling heights, ceiling types, wall types, size, etc?
 - a. Typical ceiling heights are 10', Yulee Primary School has poured-concrete ceilings remaining schools have suspended acoustical tile, concrete block walls.
- 14. Can the district provide drawings or prints for the schools included in the scope?
 - a. Not available, but we are willing to meet as responded to in question #9b.
- 15. Where will the DVD/VHS player reside? Will a shelf need to be provided by the AV contractor?
 - a. DVD/VCR will reside on a shelf that has already been installed.
- 16. The district list that the AV contractor will remove existing components, what do these components include?
 - a. See question # 9
- 17. What is the process for removed components, will the district take possession of these items, will serial numbers, room numbers, model numbers, etc need to be provided to the district.
 - a. Contractor will uninstall items.
 - b. Box similar items together, for example, projectors go together to be used as spares, wall plates controllers amps could be boxed together.
 - c. All uninstalled equipment will be returned to the District Office for disposal.
 - d. Old projector screens will be removed from the wall & brought back to the District Office & palletized for disposal.
- 18. Is on site storage available for the staging of equipment for install?
 - a. Yes, here at the District Office.
- 19. Will any software needing to be loaded on the teachers' workstation be completed by the district or will that be the responsibility of the AV Contractor?
 - a. Any required software installation will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- 20. Are the ceilings plenum?
 - a. Yes
- 21. Will surface raceway be required in the rooms?
 - a. All classrooms either have Panduit surface-mounted raceway already installed on the walls for the cabling runs to controller/wall plate, or there is conduit raceway already installed in the walls.
- 22. Does the district require advanced replacement of any other items than the projector lamps listed in the RFP?
 - a. No
- 23. What brand/model interactive boards does the district use?
 - a. We do not use interactive white boards. We do have Qomo pen pad slates.
- 24. Does the district have its own building department that provides permitting? If so is there a cost for permits?
 - a. We do our own permitting; however, there should be no need for any permits for this project.
- 25. Will all required high voltage work be performed by the district/others?
 - a. See question # 10.

- 26. For centralized district reporting/logging and control software will the district provide a server and OS licensing or will one need to be included in the pricing?
 - a. The District will provide the server & OS licensing.
