AGENDA STATEMENT: Approve awarding RFP # 2012-01 for 21st Century Classroom AV Refresh to EDCO in the amount of \$782,710.00.

ISSUE: It was determined that an RFP needed to be issued to determine the best quality and pricing for a refresh of the AV equipment in the classrooms up for refresh this year. An RFP was issued and responses were received on November 15, 2011. A committee was formed to review the information with technology personnel.

ALTERNATIVES: The Board's Alternatives are:

1. Approve the award as recommended.
2. Disapprove the award as recommended.

RECOMMENDATIONS: The Superintendent recommends approval of this request.

RATIONALE: RFP's were judged on quality of the product (50%), package price (25%), references (10%), and business capability (15%). Based on the ranking of this review EDCO was awarded the most points.

IMPACT STATEMENT: Money was budgeted for this project as part of the Technology Refresh project budgeted for 2011-2012 from the capital outlay budget. The amount of the award (\$782,710.00) is within the range of the anticipated cost.
