The District School Board of Nassau County, Fl. will soon consider a measure to increase its property tax levy.

A portion of the tax levy is required under state law in order for the school board to receive <u>\$45,244,892</u> in state education grants.

The required portion has decreased by 0.73 percent, and represents approximately seven-tenths of the total proposed taxes.

The remainder of the taxes is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.
