



2020-2021 VPK School Year Options

Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) presents each child the opportunity to perform better in school and throughout life with quality programs that include age-appropriate curricula and emphasize early literacy skills. Private, public and charter schools, private child care centers and specialized instructional services providers may offer VPK.

Based upon the results of the 2018-2019 kindergarten screening, **63% of students completing VPK were ready** for kindergarten, compared to 47% of students who attended but did not complete VPK and **39% of non-VPK students**. The VPK program provides a foundation for children entering kindergarten and beyond.

2020-2021 School Year VPK Program Options include:

- **Summer program** – 300 instructional hours with in-person instruction beginning usually in May/June
