# A Clearer Path to College



The College Board is investing \$5 million per year in the College Board Opportunity Scholarships, beginning with the class of 2020. Your students are eligible to earn scholarships by taking the following actions during certain windows in their junior and senior years:

The Scholarships	The Actions	Action Window
<b>1. Build a College List:</b> <b>\$500</b>	Build a college list on BigFuture™.	Junior Year: <b>December 10, 2018–June 2019</b>
<b>2. Practice for the SAT:</b> <b>\$1,000</b>	Use Official SAT® Practice on Khan Academy® to get ready for test day.	Junior Year and Fall Senior Year: <b>December 10, 2018–October 2019</b>
<b>3. Improve Score:</b> <b>\$2,000</b>	Improve their SAT score.	Spring Junior Year through Fall Senior Year: <b>March 2019–December 2019</b>
<b>4. Strengthen College List:</b> <b>\$500</b>	Strengthen their college list with a mix of academic safety, fit, and reach schools.	Summer and Fall Senior Year: <b>July 2019–October 2019</b>
<b>5. Complete the FAFSA:</b> <b>\$1,000</b>	Fill out the FAFSA form to apply for financial aid.	Fall and Winter Senior Year: <b>October 2019–January 2020</b>
<b>6. Apply to Colleges:</b> <b>\$1,000</b>	Apply to schools they want to attend.	Fall and Winter Senior Year: <b>October 2019–February 2020</b>
<b>Complete the Journey:</b> <b>\$40,000</b>	Complete all six scholarship steps.	Final Drawing: <b>March 2020</b>
