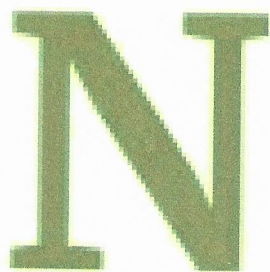

All work will be presented within the application portfolio and meet the application requirements. **(Details on page 4)**

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?**

The scholarship application is open to all Nassau County School Seniors who will graduate in the spring of 2023 from a Nassau County High School.

### **HOW TO APPLY.**

- 1)** All applicants must complete and return the scholarship application no later than **February 1, 2023**.
- 2)** All applicants must include two (2) letters of recommendation. One (1) from a teacher or other Nassau County School official and one (1) from a personal reference.
- 3)** Applicants must complete a portfolio with the above application and letters of recommendations included no later than **February 1, 2023**.

All portfolios must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by **February 1, 2023**.

## **Application Portfolio Guidelines**

Each submission must be in the form of a personal portfolio which includes information and verification of the applicants participation, creation, or implementation of a community outreach project.

The following items must be included within the portfolio:

**Cover Page.** The cover page should include the student's name and Nassau County High School they will graduate from in the spring of 2023;

**Section 1:** The completed and signed scholarship application;

**Section 2:** Letters of recommendation, (1) from a Nassau County School teacher or official, and (1) from a personal reference;

**Section 3:** Name of project you volunteered, created, or implemented within Nassau County that provided a resource or benefit to the residents of Nassau County.

**Section 4:** Synopsis of your interest, participation, and outcomes of the project.

*If you have volunteered or participated in more than 1 project, you will need to create a separate section for each project you are submitting. For example: if you participated or volunteered for 3 non-profit organizations over the past 3 years, you should create a separate section for each project. The years of participation should be listed.*

**Each section should include the 1) name of the project, 2) the years of participation, 3) photos of your participation if available, and 4) the name, title and phone number or email of the representative that may be contacted for participation verification.**

**All submissions should be placed in a portfolio folder.**

**Each page should be numbered at the bottom right-hand corner.**

**Portfolios must include the: 1) application, 2) recommendation letters, and 3) community outreach participation information and summary.**

***\*\*Incomplete portfolios will not be considered for award.***
