Unaccompanied Homeless Youth (UHY)?

(UHY=not living with a parent or legal guardian)

Florida House Bill (HB) 1577 was approved by Governor DeSantis on April 6, 2022, with an effective date of July 1, 2022. This bill enacts the following:

- Revises the definition of homeless youth for the purposes of Florida tuition exemption.
- Requires school districts to provide information cards to certified homeless unaccompanied youth (16 and older), which include the youth's rights as well as certification information.
- Requires school districts and postsecondary institutions to provide postsecondary transition counseling to homeless students identified through McKinney-Vento.





Ask your middle school staff about this great opportunity for before or afterschool activities. Transportation may be possible through the FIT program.
