**Rapid Rehousing Navigator** - Carlos- (904) 358-2411, ext.229 for "literally homeless" (living in a car or shelter, or the camp space or motel bill is being paid by an agency or church) or Dawn Gilman (904) 354-1100. Coordinated Intake- (904)354-1100.

**NE FL Community Action** - helps with electric deposits, Youth summer program, self-sufficiency program (employment) and can coordinate a 20% discount for child care at certain facilities. 261-0801. Currently has additional funds for Covid 19-related needs. M,T,Th,F - 10am-noon and 1pm-4pm.

**Salvation Army** - helps with back rent, rapid-rehousing, FPL bills, gas, and emergency travel expenses. 321-0435

**Barnabas Center** - provides some of the same services as NE FL Community Action and Salvation Army, and many other services as well, such as dental and medical clinics. 261-7000

**Habitat for Humanity**- helps families purchase their own home. Household incomes \$19,290-\$43,620.

**The subsidized housing units listed above (all of them except for the motels and Nassau Club Apartments) may require an application fee, but most are not required until a unit is available (4-6 months, at least). There are waiting lists, so go ahead and apply as soon as possible.**
