-breve /breev/: the coding mark for a short vowel

-closed vowel: a vowel that is followed by a consonant, whether at the end of the word at the end of a syllable; it is coded with a breve

-combinations: letters that come togehther to make a sound that would not seem typical of the two letters; these are coded with an arch underneath

star butter bird horse quilt turtle whale -**digraph**: letters that come together to make one sound; can be consonant digraphs or vowel digraphs; these are coded with an underline

ch, sh, ck, ng, ph, th ai, au, aw, ay, ee, ea, ei, ew, ey, ie, oo, ou, ow, ue

-final stable syllables: a syllable found at the end of the word that will always say the same thing; it is coded with a bracket

[ble [dle [fle [gle [ple [tle [sion [tion [ture [tious [cious -macron /may-kron/: the coding mark for a long vowel

-**open vowel**: a vowel that is not followed by anything, whether at the end of the word or at the end of a syllable; it is coded with a macron

-**trigraph**: three letters that come together to make one sound; these are coded with an underline

dge igh tch -vowel consonant e: a word or syllable that ends with a vowel letter, then a consonant letter, then the letter e; the last e is crossed off, the vowel is coded with a macron
