## DONATION OF SICK LEAVE Florida Statute: 1012.61 (2)(e)(2)

An employee (donor) of the District may donate up to fifty percent (50%) of his/her accumulated sick leave, not to exceed twenty-five (25) days, to another employee (recipient) for his/her own personal serious illness or injury. The donor must retain at least eight (8) sick leave days after authorized days have been donated.

Directions: This Request to Donate Sick Leave should be completed by the donating employee. Sick leave deducted from each donor's sick leave balance shall be in proportion to the need approved. Unused donated sick leave shall be returned to the donor(s) in proportion to that donated by all donors.
