Instructions for Requesting Bereavement Leave

Full-time personnel are eligible for bereavement leave in order to attend the funeral and to attend to other relatedarrangements in the event of the death of a family member.

In accordance with the NTA Contract, employees must have exhausted their own sick leave in order to be eligible for Bereavement Leave.

Five (5) Consecutive Work Days

Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Spouse, Child, Grandparent, Grandchild, Stepparent, Stepbrother, Stepsister, or Stepchild.

Three (3) Consecutive Work Days

Father-in-law, Mother-in-law, Brother-in-law, Sister-in-law, Son-in-law, Daughter-in-law, or Grandparent-in-law.

Steps to Request Bereavement Leave:

- Submit a request letter to Mr. Scott Hodges requesting payment Bereavement Leave.
- 2. The letter must be accompanied by supporting documentation, such as official notice of death, a copy of the certificate of death, a newspaper obituary, or the funeral program.
- 3. Such leave, if approved, shall be taken in equivalent work hours.
