  - A child or spouse of a U.S military member (current or retired)
  - A current or retired U.S Military member.
- Education:
  - 1. High School location & dates
  - 2. Colleges / Trade Schools location, dates
  - 3. If still in school, include Grade Point Average, expected date of graduation
- Work Experience: Employer, Job Description, Dates of Employment
- Honors, Scholastic Achievement, and/or Community Service, Leadership and Extracurricular Activities.
- Qualifications: Please list any applicable licenses and certificates.
- Essay: 500 words or less describe what military service means to you, your county, and your community, and how do you envision your future service to the country and the community (military or otherwise).
- Letters of Recommendation: At least two letters of recommendation, from educator or employer, to support your application are required.
