Dear Parent or Guardian:

Pursuant to Section 1002.45 (1)(b), Florida Statutes, all school districts must provide parents with timely written notification of at least one open enrollment period for full-time virtual instruction students of 90 days or more which ends 30 days before the first day of the school year.

The Nassau County School District has been rated an "A" school district for 11 of the last 13 years since the inception of the district grading program. Parents may rest assured that our schools continue their tradition of providing excellent academic challenges every day to meet the needs of all students and help them achieve their learning goals. We want families to understand that a full-time virtual instruction program is only one of the options offered to students.

For self-motivated learners who know how to organize their time and see tasks through to completion, virtual school courses may be a good fit. Parents of students taking virtual courses must be prepared to commit to a schedule of monthly calls with the virtual school teacher to review academic progress. ,


