 - a. Attendance, Reading, Math & Science improvement: Attendance is still an issue but mid-year data is positive and encouraging.

 - a. Overall, very positive responses
 - b. Questions that had a lower positive percentage.
 - i. Has your child's school hosted or scheduled meetings, events and/or trainings to help you support your child in school? 60% (30) Yes; 12.5% (6) No; 25% (12) IDK: BES has hosted numerous events through-out the school year
 - ii. If you were given materials to enable you to help your child perform better in school, did someone explain or show you how to use the materials? 68% (34) Y; 20% (10) N; 12%(6) IDK
 - iii. Have you received info from your child's school about the Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) standards? 75.51% (37) Y; 10.20% (5) N; 14.29% (7) IDK: A B.E.S.T Standards Night was held in November.
 - iV. Have you received info from your child's school about Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.) testing? 73.47% (36) Y; 12.24% (6) N; 14.29% (7) IDK: Parent letters have gone home twice so far. One at the beginning of each testing window.
