Fever free for 24 hours without using fever reducing medicine like Tylenol or Motrin	Free from vomiting for at least 2 solid meals	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours	Free from rash, itching, or fever and evaluated by a medical provider if needed	Received appropriate lice treatment at home and clear of active lice and nits	Evaluated by a medical provider and have a note to return to school	Released by a medical provider to return to school
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
