Student Survey

Students surveyed at Bryceville Elementary showed an overall committed level of engagement in the areas of behavioral and emotional engagement. Survey selections such as: I always try to do my best, I look forward to going to school, I am helpful, I like to collaborate, my teachers care, my learning is helpful were selected by over 75% of students. In the area of cognitive engagement answers to three out of the seven questions fell in the compliant level of engagement. Survey selections such as: I work so I can make good grades, helps me on tests, to move onto next grade. These statements show extrinsic motivation to their learning. We need to help students see that motivation for learning needs to come from within. Intrinsic vs extrinsic.

Staff Survey

Bryceville Elementary scored above the network average in all areas. The highest area was Leadership for School Improvement at 3.55. More specifically C1: The curriculum at my school is based on clearly defined standards for student learning and F1 My school promotes quality instruction by both fostering an academic learning climate and actively supporting teaching and learning both at 3.69. The area of Curriculum was a 3.51 which was the lowest rating. Specifically, G1 My school builds the skill required to improve through comprehensive professional development programs focused on my school's goals for improvement and G2 My school builds the skill required to improve through ongoing professional development programs focused on my school's goals for improvement both at 3.31.

Parent Survey

Bryceville Elementary scored above the network average in all areas. The highest areas were Purpose and Direction and Governance and Leadership at 5.0. According to my parent survey, our school has high expectations for students in all classes and our school communicates effectively about the school's goals and activities. In the area of Using Results of Continuous Improvement the school scored a 4.18. An area that the parent survey revealed was the biggest area of growth to be helping student see the relationship between what is being taught and his/her everyday life.
