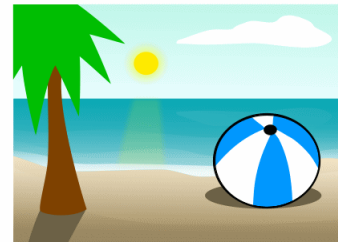
Humm... maybe learn about Ancient China!!!
