- **School Improvement Title I:**
 - School Improvement plan review/update
 - Attendance Goal: Goal is for the 90% subgroup to increase by 5%. The percentage has actually gone down.
 - Incentives to promote attendance discussed: 1. Teachers will post a sign outside of their classroom door when all students are in attendance. Officer Valentine will step in and congratulate the class. 2. Admin will have a perfect attendance popcorn party during lunches to promote attendance.
 - Subgroup: Intentional additional instruction for students: African American students fell below goal.
 - Solutions discussed to target these students: 1. Intervention and teacher tutoring. 2. K. Collins will begin pulling students who don't receive services in order to provide additional targeted instruction.
 - PM2 Data: District data was shared. Math: CES was 1st for 1st grade; 2nd for 2nd Grade; Reading: CES was 4th for K; 1st for 1st grade; 1st for 2nd grade. The school wide push is now to see how we can focus to get our lowest quartile students scores improved.
 - SIP mid-year review input/parental input: Attendance Goals: Officer Valentine stopping by to congratulate classes. Classes that have had perfect attendance for the week can be announced on the morning announcements.
 - Title I Survey Results: Results were reviewed and there will be a focus on informing parents of the resources that are available to them to help with their child's education. Suggestion to add that information to Remind account once a nine weeks was given. .
